- Traffic Police has advised that extra demerit points will be given for traffic offences in school zone. Class monitor, please collect letter from Traffic Police for parents.


Crossing @ Maplewood Park

Cross only when the Green Man is on




CRA-TONN

- 3.30pm to 6.00pm only when it is raining


After 3:30 pm, exit using side gate. Do not walk through Main Gate




Use the walkway outside PE room / Gym /SFE room

SIGNALISED PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS

Do not cross



Do not start to cross (flashing green man) – It will turn red.









Countdown timers show the amount of time left for you to cross.

CROSSING THE ROAD SAFELY

Apply the kerb drill before crossing the road.

- Look Right
- Look Left
- Look Right Again



- Ensure all vehicles have stopped. R your hand High Up and Cross Briskly.
 - Raise your hand when crossing.
- Do not cross in between parked vehicles or in front of stationary vehicles.




Do not SMS or use gadgets like handphones or portable devices. Always be attentive and alert on road.
