Merit

Overall Percentage at Sec 2 and Subject Eligibility Criteria

Choice

• Rank order – 1st Choice will be considered if the results meet the subject criteria

Vacancy

• Availability of places in a particular option combination

Subjects offered depends on:

- Take-up rate a subject will not be offered if the take-up rate is not met
- Availability of teachers a subject will have a maximum cohort size if too many students opt for it.



Subject classes

Points to note:

- There must be <u>20</u> or more students choosing this particular option before the school will consider opening the class.
- Student <u>cannot</u> be a school and private candidate at the same time. Therefore, student cannot sit for any subject at the national examinations as a private candidate.

* Subjected to availability of staff resource. At <u>maximum</u> the school can offer 1 Pure Literature and 1 Elective Literature class. If additional teacher resource is available, we may extend to 2 Elective Literature classes across the Express combinations.

^ Art/Music will be offered as the 8th subject. They will be conducted at the same time with the 8th subject-offerings under Options 1 and 2. The 8th subject will be offered at the end of the schooling day.

Points to note:

- 1. To be eligible for Option 1 (Physics 3rd Pure Science subject),
- students should obtain a minimum average of 70% for English Language, Science and Mathematics.
- student should obtain an overall average of 70% and above.
- subject to minimum of 20 students and maximum of 40 students class size per subject.
- 2. To be eligible for Option 1 or 2 (2nd Pure Humanities subject),
- students should obtain a minimum average of 65% for English Language, Science and Mathematics.
- student should obtain an overall average of 65% and above.
- subjected to minimum of 20 students and maximum of 40 students class size per subject.
- offering of the Pure Literature subject is subjected to the availability of manpower resources for the year.
- 3. Subjects Additional Mathematics, Pure Literature, Pure Geography are offered in Option 3.
- to be eligible for these subjects, students should obtain a **minimum** of **65%** for Sec 2 Mathematics, Literature, Geography (Express).
- subjected to minimum of 20 students and maximum of 40 students class size per subject.
- offering of the **Pure Literature** subject is subjected to the availability of manpower resources for the year.
- 4. Art & Music are subjects that will be conducted in the afternoon, students should obtain the following.
- to be eligible for Art, students should obtain a minimum of 65% for Sec 2 Art.
- to be eligible for Art and Music, students should pass an audition and interview.

5. Students who are currently taking 3rd languages, they will be having a total of 8/9 subjects.







- 1. How do I know my allocated subject combinations?
- Students need to login to the portal to obtain your assigned subject combination on **30 Oct, 12 noon**.
- Is it possible to appeal after the subject combination is assigned? 2.
- Yes, it is possible. However, students are filled into the subject vacancies based on the 1st round of assignment, if the class/subject vacancies are full, the school will not be able to fulfill the appeal request.
- 3. How do we go about the appeal process? How many options can I appeal for?
- Students need to login to the portal to submit your appeal option and reasons. You can only appeal for **1 option**.

Must I take triple science to enter a science stream in a JC?

No you do not.

JCs do not offer triple sciences. In JC students are required to take 4 content subjects, of which one must be math and another contrasting subject (not science). Students should consider taking triple sciences only if they have **done well** in their science and **met the requirement** to qualify as triple sciences is a very demanding course. They should show a strong passion and aptitude in sciences.
